Óbuda University

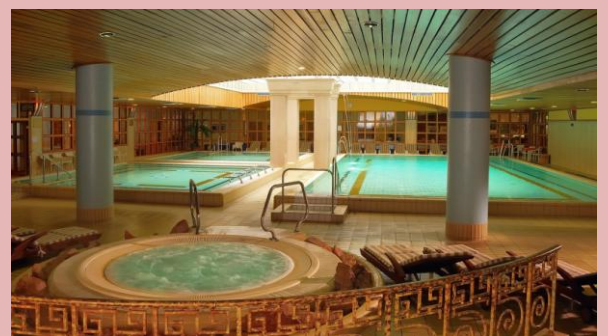


Óbuda University is a dynamic and thriving institution located in Budapest, Hungary. For 135 years of existence, the educational excellence has remained paramount. A comprehensive academic program has been implemented, with emphasis on competitive, flexible and high-level training, scientific research and development. A focused, technologically based education is offered on a wide range, from undergraduate to PhD programs, for around 12000 students in a stimulating environment at six faculties – Alba Regia Technical Faculty, Bánki Donát Faculty of Mechanical and Safety Engineering, Kandó Kálmán Faculty of Electrical Engineering, Keleti Károly Faculty of Business and Management, John von Neumann Faculty of Informatics, Rejtő Sándor Faculty of Light Industry Engineering and Environmental Protection Engineering –, one educational centre – Trefort Ágoston Centre for Engineering Education – and three Doctoral Schools of Applied Informatics and Applied Mathematics; Materials Sciences and Technologies; Safety and Security Sciences. The mission of the university is to serve the economy through development and high-level knowledge transfer and innovation. The program of education is balanced to meet the demands of long-lasting basic knowledge, up-to-date professional and practical knowledge, and the application of these. The education process is built on the human relations and cooperative abilities of the students and professors. Place of Venue
